

A taste of Burgundy

Olivier Leflaive gives you a homely welcome in the heart of Puligny-Montrachet.

"Welcome to the house!" is the way that Olivier Leflaive likes to greet you when you step through the grand entrance. "La Table d'Olivier Leflaive" is still in Puligny-Montrachet but is now housed in a superbly restored 17th century building. In the restaurant, there is minimum fuss. The most important thing is that people can eat simple local food, while tasting a selection of wines from the Maison Olivier Leflaive (Meursault, Saint-Aubin, Puligny, Chassagne, Corton-Charlemagne, and more). "Make sure you allow at least two hours for lunch here!" laughs Olivier. It must be said that each wine served is commented upon and explained in a cheery atmosphere where the whole dining room benefits from the strong confident tones of the sommelier. The hotel meanwhile is "luxurious, calm and sensual". There is nothing amiss. Each of the 12 rooms has its own style, in soft or shimmering tones; Olivier's sister took care of decoration. And as if board and lodgings were not enough, the establishment also offers fuss-free excursions to cater to all tastes: vineyard work for an hour or a day, or gastronomic, cultural or strenuous walks, taking in the inexhaustible discoveries of Burgundy. A magical home with a magical heart. You will not be disappointed. ■
